School Quarantine Guidance

What to do when a student is exposed to COVID-19 but doesn't have symptoms.

Masking helps keep kids in the classroom.

Students who test positive should not be in school until cleared by local health department.

Unvaccinated, 0-6 feet (one or both students unmasked)

STAY HOME

Return after 7 days if negative test on day 6 or 7
OR return after 10 days if asymptomatic
the entire time.
