- Principal's Report: Mrs. Carruth
  - 1. The school is not opened because Oakland and Wayne Counties are now at a Level E; Mr. Shepich sent teachers home to begin working from home as Covid-19 cases rise in our area. At the Board meeting on Thursday, there will not be a recommendation to reopen the school yet. Mrs. Carruth assured the community that the school is ready to open with the proper safety protocols in place when it is safe to do so. While we wait to reopen, please continue to support each other in these unprecedented times. While we all may not agree with things being how they are, we truly cannot do anything but our best with what we are working with.
  - 2. The November Supply Pick-Up is scheduled for November 13, 2020. There will be one pick-up in November, and one in December that is scheduled for December 4<sup>th</sup>.
  - 3. **Asynchronous Afternoons** will happen when teachers have professional training, a teacher is absent, or if there are teacher meetings scheduled during normal class meeting times. We experienced an asynchronous afternoon last week when teachers had professional training to learn about the new resource- NearPod.
  - 4. **Stamina**: Student stamina is noticeably slipping. It is the recommendation that all students have a learning space that mitigates loud noises/ distractions and with a set schedule



The Grandview Staff deeply believes that supporting the parents of virtual learners is just as important as supporting the student. Topics will rotate between RULER social/emotional support, tech support for parents, and literacy. GV Parent Virtual Café will start on November 17, 2020 and will be focused on RULER.
